Jacobson Operation Receives Carrier of the Year Award

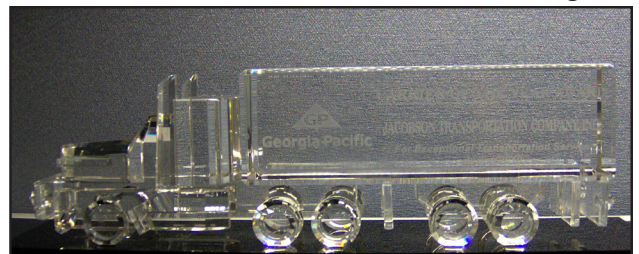
In April 2008, Jacobson received a contract as the dedicated carrier for the Georgia Pacific plant in West Chester, Ohio. On July 11 of this year, Jacobson received the renewal contract to remain Georgia Pacific's dedicated carrier. CSA 2010 Up and Running!

We are now in the 9th month under the new DOT carrier and driver safety review program. As expected, the program has had a major impact on the industry. The most critical is that drivers are now receiving points for violations at roadsides and for accidents. Based on your score, the DOT can take enforcement action against an individual driver. Many carriers are now using a driver's CSA 2010 score in reviewing driver applicants.



One of the misconceptions of the program is that the rules for inspections changed. The only change was that now every violation has been assigned a number of points based on the seriousness of the violation. An out-of-service is still an out-of-service, but additional points are assigned to that inspection. They also weigh the points based on when the inspection was completed. A 5 point violation counts as 15 for the first six months and then is reduced as time passes. All roadside points and accidents will be on your record for 3 years.

Another thing that hasn't changed is what the driver needs to do to operate safely and avoid getting CSA 2010 points. Obey all traffic laws, do a thorough pre and post trip inspection and maintain accurate and current logs. Even though you don't own the equipment, all violations go against your record. One of our most frequent violations is with equipment lights. Lights should not only be checked on the pre and post trip inspection, but anytime you are stopped. Jacobson has provided you with light kits to assist you in preventing these violations. You cannot just "rubber stamp" a pre trip inspection. Any deficiency you discover on a pre trip should be reported so that it can be corrected. In addition, a thorough post trip should be completed and submitted in writing on the DVIR.

All moving violations that are noted on the inspection also are assigned points even if you do not receive an actual citation. Another frequent violation we are seeing is in keeping your logbook current. This is a major violation and probably the most easy to prevent. With logs and inspections you cannot afford to get complacent!

At Jacobson we are doing everything possible to assist you in obtaining a 0 point violation. If you receive a clean inspection, please take advantage of our reward program through the company store; you deserve it!

CSA 2010 violation points will have a direct impact on your driving career. In most cases, you are the only one that can take the steps necessary to avoid accidents and to obtain a clean inspection. Please let us know any ideas you have to help our drivers and the company with CSA 2010.

Driving Safety Tips

Here are some Driving Safety Tips to keep in mind at this time of the year.:

- **Pay Attention.** Be aware of children walking, running or biking. Children will be on and near the road in the morning and after school hours, and keep in mind that they may be walking in between parked cars.
- **Plan ahead.** You don't want to find yourself feeling stressed or rushed when passing through school zones, so build some extra time into your schedule or consider modifying your route to avoid congested school zones.
- **Avoid distractions.** Reduce distractions inside your vehicle so you can concentrate on the road and your surroundings. Turn off your cell phone, don't be eating or drinking and be well rested.
- **Know the law!** Drive no faster than 15 m.p.h in or near a school zone, and remember that school zones are non-passing zones. Finally, always stop for school buses that are loading or unloading students.
